Did you know?

- In 19/20 the PSNI responded to 31,817 domestic abuse incidents – that is one approx every 17 minutes of every day.
- PSNI statistics show that 1 in 3 victims of domestic abuse are men.
- UK figures show 4 in 10 Gay & Bi Men have experienced domestic abuse for more than a year.
- UK figures show 49% of Gay & Bi men has experienced at least 1 incident of domestic abuse since the age of 16 years old (perpetrator can be family member or intimate partner).
