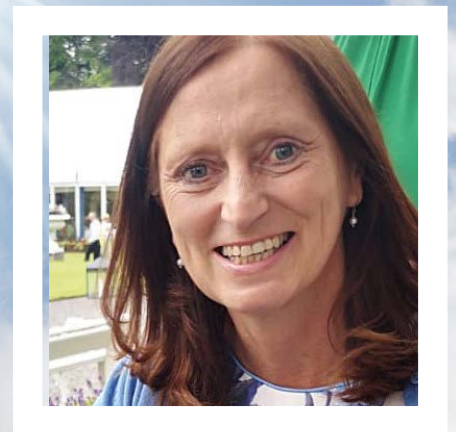


West Belfast Festival Health Lecture - Supporting the Health and Wellbeing of Asylum Seekers and Refugees

This lecture will cover the challenges faced by people who arrive here to seek sanctuary and explore how we as communities, organisations and individuals can play a role in welcoming and supporting people to rebuild their lives in Belfast.

Denise Wright qualified as a nurse in 1986 and worked in North and West Belfast as a community nurse in the 1990's. For the past 16 years she has been Race Relations Coordinator for South Belfast Roundtable retiring in June this year. In this role she coordinated the NI Refugee and Asylum Forum and she remains involved in this area of work in a voluntary and independent capacity. As well as working with people in the asylum system in Belfast she has visited refugee camps and led learning visits overseas.
