Information correct at January 2023



Introduction

This booklet has been developed to inform carers of concessions and discounts that may be available to them across Belfast and Northern Ireland.

Some visitor attractions and leisure facilities offer discounts to both carers and the cared for person. You may be asked for evidence of your caring role which should be dated within the last 12 months. We recommend that you contact the venue that you wish to visit before booking to ensure that you have the necessary documentation to hand on entry.

The Belfast Trust Carer ID card may assist entry to a variety of places, as evidence of your current carer status. We recommend that you carry it with you when out and about to assist other forms of ID that might be required when booking in to visitor attractions.

Autism NI Card

Carers can apply to become a member of Autism NI for £20 a year or £5 if you are in receipt of benefits. To apply, access an application form at the above website under become a member and return by post, phone or online and return to Autism NI, Donard, Knockbracken, Healthcare Park, Saintfield Road, Belfast, BT8 8BH. You will be provided with an Autism NI card which is valid for a year and can be used at various venues.

This card permits free access for a carer accompanying a disabled person to the cinema. The card lasts three years; costs £6.00 and has unlimited use. The person applying must be in receipt of Disability Living Allowance; Attendance Allowance; or registered blind.

Essential Companion / Carer Requirements

The Waterfront Hall and Ulster Hall can provide a complimentary Essential Companion or Carer ticket if a cared for person requires continual assistance or supervision during the visit. The companion must be over 18 years of age, and be able to assist in the event of an evacuation.

To be eligible to apply for a Carer Ticket, the person applying should be in receipt of one of the following:

- Disability Living Allowance (DLA) or Attendance Allowance (AA)
- Personal Independence Payment (PIP)
- Certificate of Visual Impairment
- Disabled SmartPass / Blue Badge holder
- Employment and Support Allowance (ESA).
- Industrial Injuries Disablement Benefit (IIDB)
- Constant Attendance Allowance
- Armed Forces Compensation Scheme (Guaranteed Income Payment)
- Cred – Ability Card
- Medical Authorisation

Carer's entry

Visitors paying standard admission price who require special assistance are offered free admission for one accompanying carer. To gain free carer's admission, the carer must provide proof (in the form of documentation) to show that you are in receipt of carer's allowance, a doctor's letter or other relevant paperwork. Alternatively, the visitor who needs a carer can provide evidence of requiring a carer.

Application for Accessible Tickets

When a complimentary essential companion ticket is required to support a cared for person to attend an event, Accessible Tickets are available via an application form. The cared for person must be largely dependent upon a wheelchair and able to provide proof in the form of a doctors/hospital letter or prove a disability benefit, such as PIP or DLA. Please note: Blue Accessible Parking badges are not accepted.

An essential companion must be capable of supporting the needs of the accessible ticket holder throughout the fixture and in the event of an emergency and therefore the essential companion should not be a junior.

Personal Assistant Tickets

The SSE Arena offer a number of Personal Assistant tickets* (previously known as Essential Aid tickets) **at a discount or no additional cost**. This is eligible to customers who meet the criteria and would be unable to attend an event without the support of another person, who can assist in the event of an emergency. These tickets need to be applied for via Ticketmaster's online booking, and required evidence submitted to Ticketmaster ahead of the event. *subject to availability

How to apply

Tickets within the wheelchair areas can be purchased online at www.ticketmaster.ie and tickets for other access requests such as for visual or hearing impaired customers can be seen by clicking the accessible symbol on the individual event page, below the title on Ticketmaster.

If purchasing a ticket for a Personal Assistant via the Ticketmaster website, you will be contacted to submit evidence of entitlement within 72 hours of purchase. (Please note, The SSE Arena, Belfast follows criteria provided by Attitude of what evidence is required).

If you have a disability which requires you to be accompanied, your companion may attend free of charge/at a discounted rate (subject to concessionary rates agreed with promoter). Patrons must register with the box office in advance and join up to Centrestage or fill out the access form.

Where applicable, concession rates are available to under 18's, students, unwaged, over 60's and disabled patrons. Simply select your ticket type when booking online to receive this discount or request a concession when booking with box office. A proof of status will be required when collecting concession tickets.

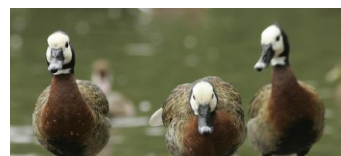

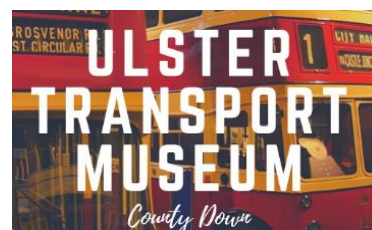

It includes access to the rides & attractions subject to height/medical restrictions. If more than one carer is required, all carers may be provided with free access to the park if evidence (a headed letter or card) can be presented at the entrance till points. Once you select an Additional needs ticket, this rate includes one accompanying carer entry FOC.
