

Black, Asian, Minority Ethnic and Refugee (BAMER) Women facing Domestic Abuse, Honour Based Violence, Forced Marriage and Female Genital Mutilation (FGM) Seminar

With thanks to funding from Belfast Area PCSP, the Belfast Domestic & Sexual Violence and Abuse Partnership are offering a free seminar looking at BAMER women facing domestic abuse, honour based violence, forced marriage and FGM.

This seminar will highlight the particular issues facing BAMER women who are experiencing domestic abuse. It will promote a greater cultural understanding of these obstacles and raise awareness of the legal remedies available with regards to both civil and immigration law. It will discuss the increasing threat of honour based violence experienced by women in Northern Ireland and raise awareness of the frequency of Female Genital Mutilation in the U.K.

The seminar will also highlight men's experience of forced marriage and so called honour based violence and the impacts. This session will feature input from partner agencies as well as input from Dr Maz Idriss.
