

Where did the modern hospital building come from? Whatever happened to the Nightingale ward? This talk will explore the history of the NHS through its buildings. It will look at the hospitals that were originally acquired in 1948 and how hospital design evolved to reflect the ideals of post-war society.

About the speaker: Dr Harriet Blakeman is an architectural historian who is a specialist in the history of hospital design. In 2015 she set up the Historic-Hospitals website in order to make her work more widely accessible. Her PhD studied post war hospital design in the first 50 years of the NHS in Scotland.
